



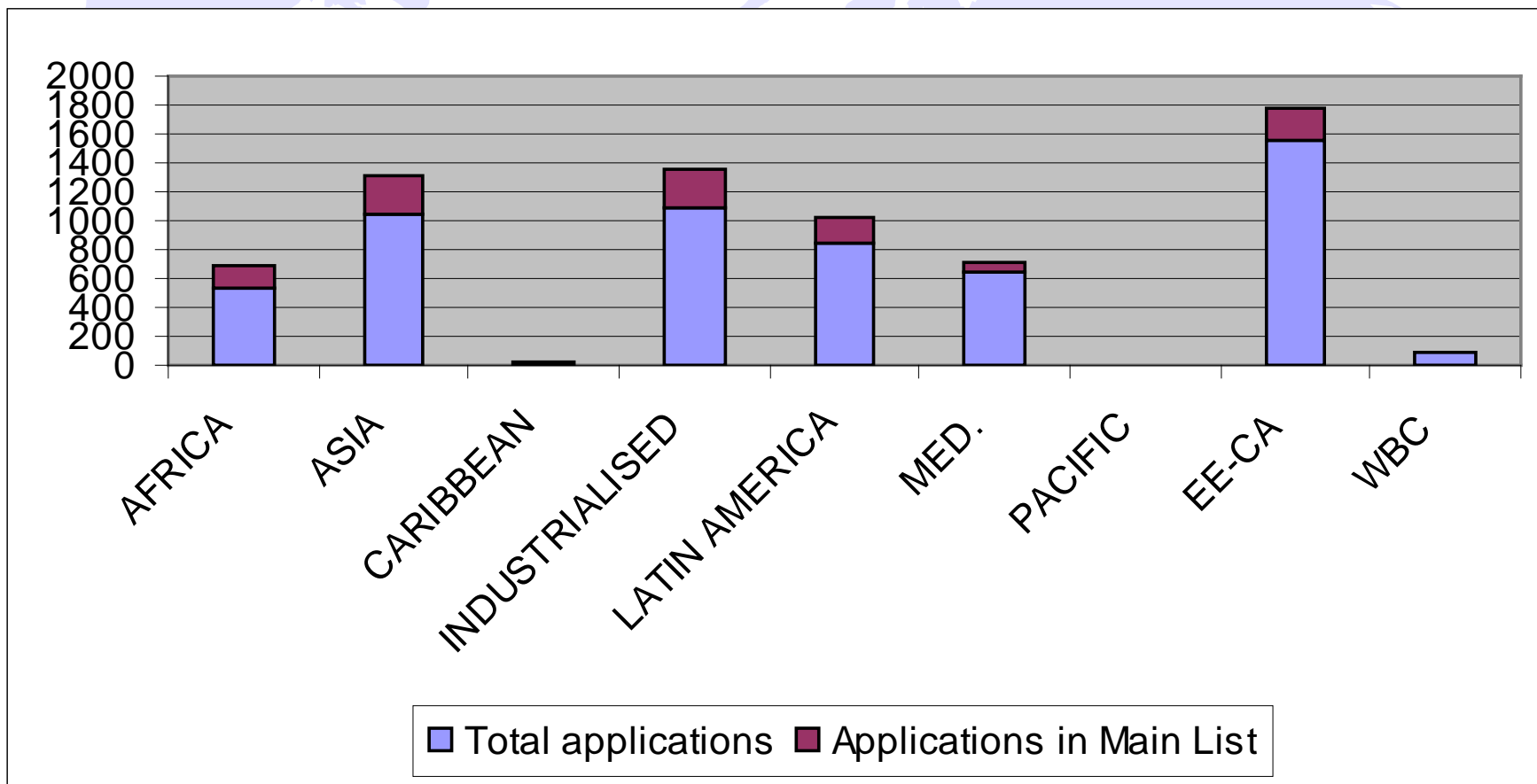

Total application by ICPC countries

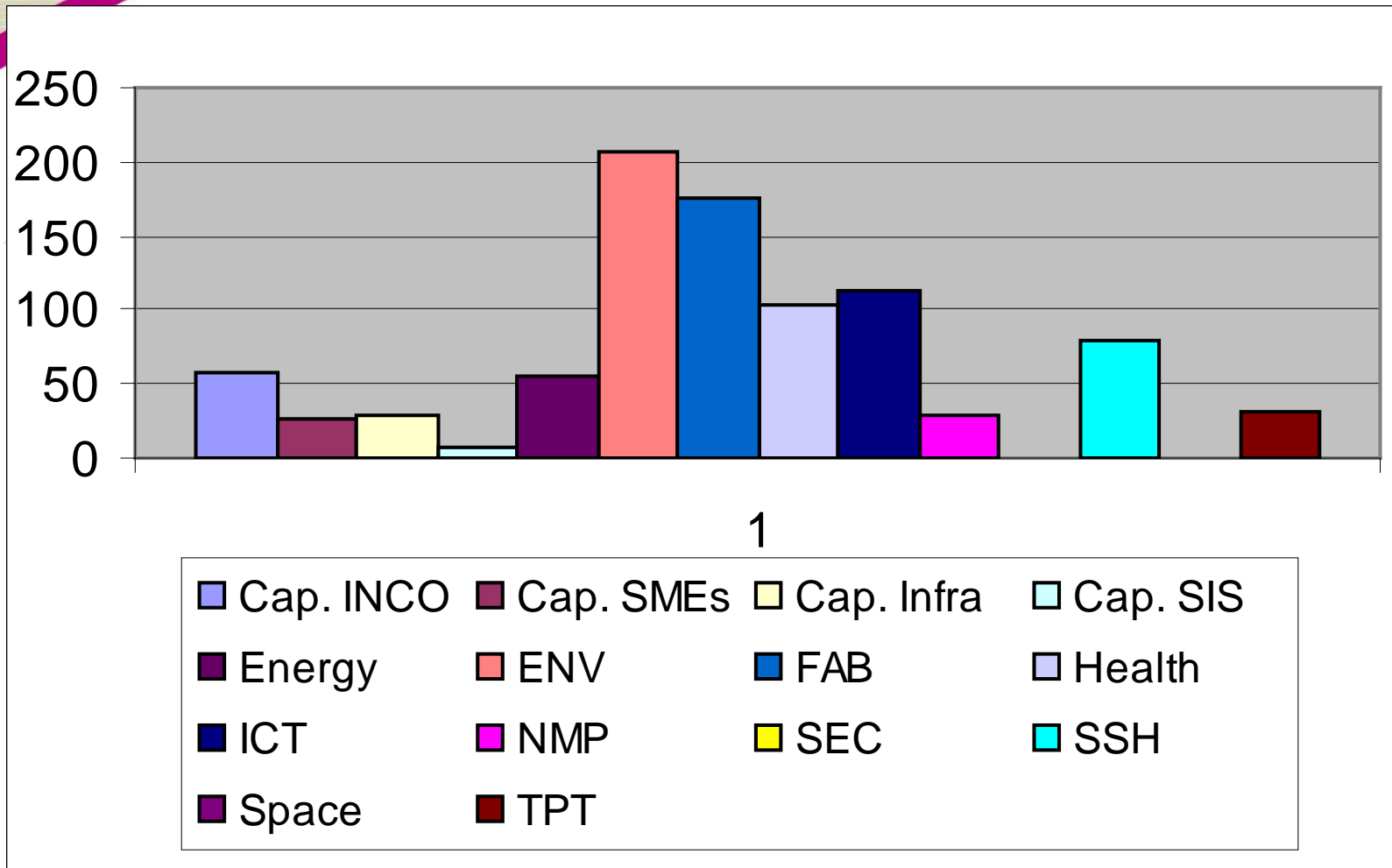

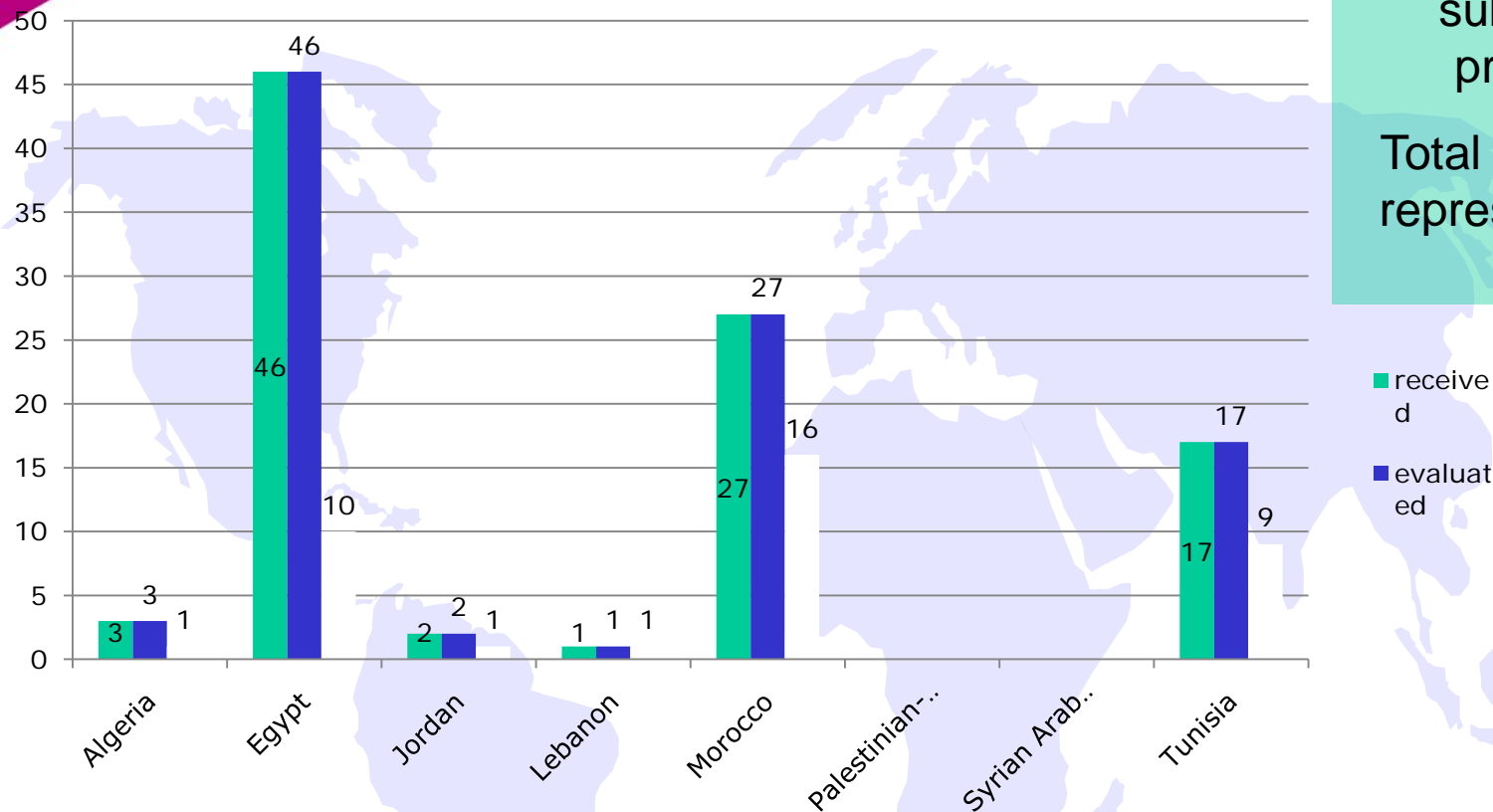

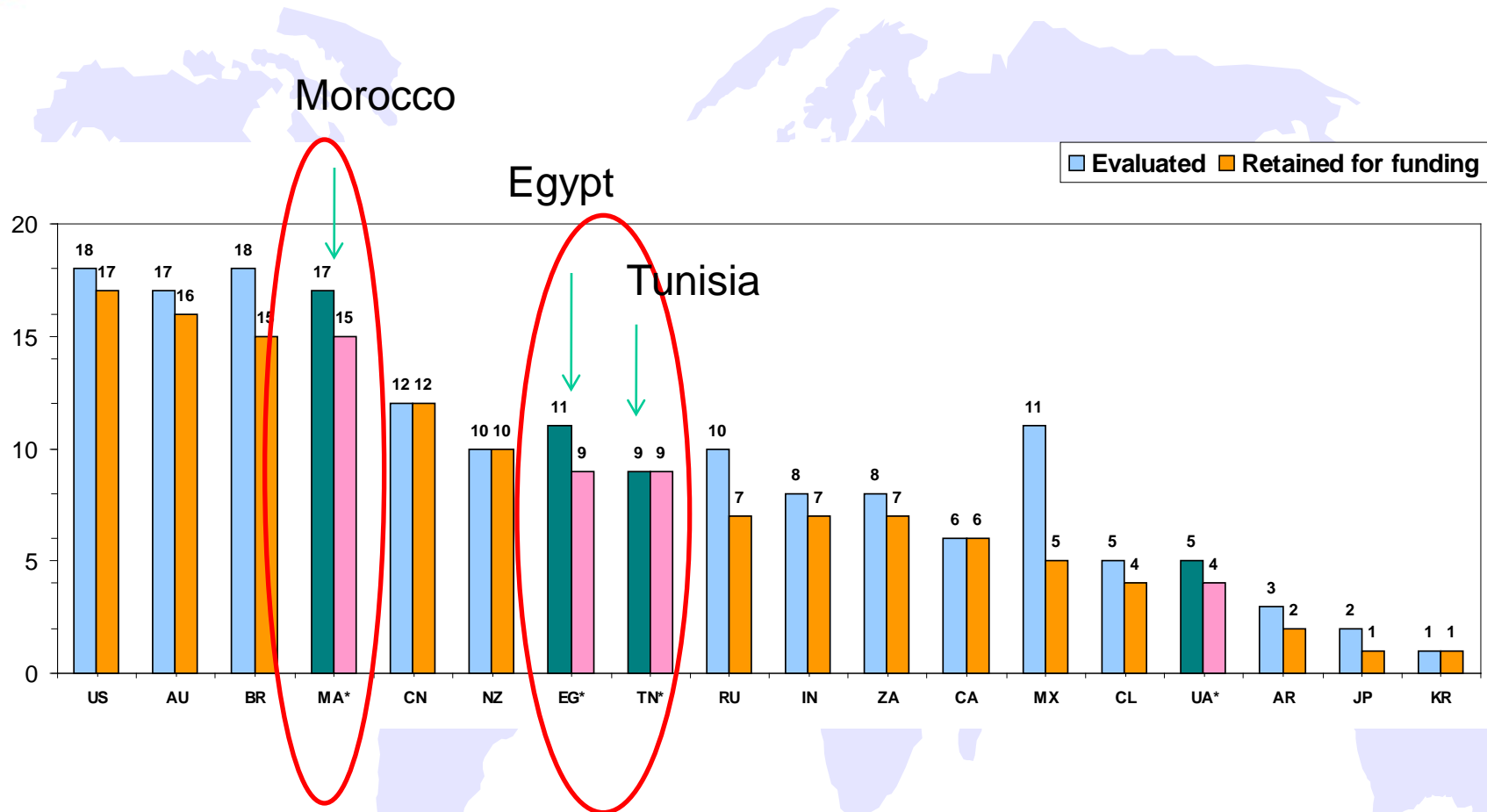
MPC participation in FP7 People program (2008)

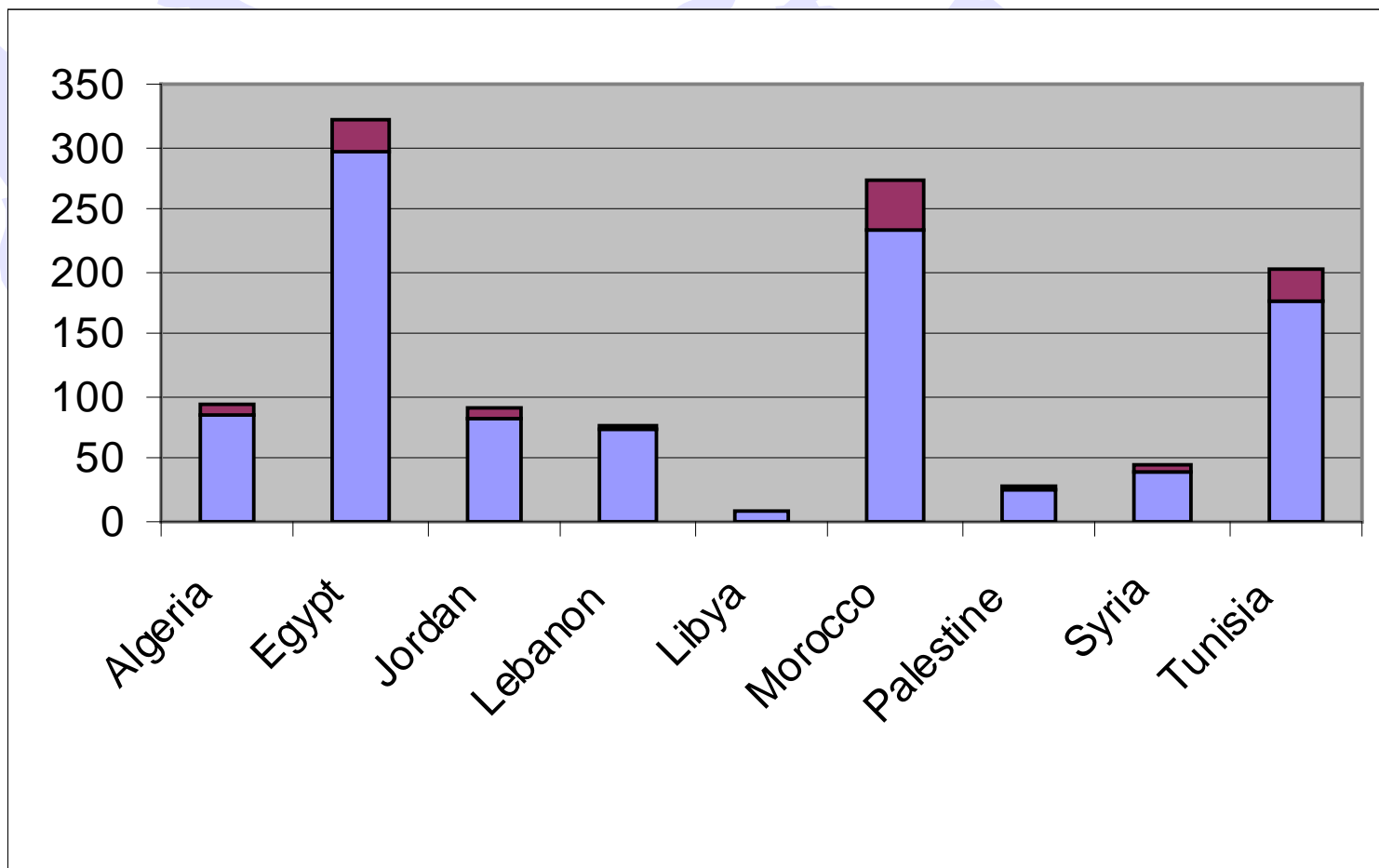
